SECTION 2. 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in Section 6 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June 1, 2025. Sections 2, 4, and 5 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and 1 month and, at the end of June 30, 2027, Sections 2, 4, and 5 of this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
