- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (A) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND ENERGY 21 ADMINISTRATION, SHALL:
- 22 (1) ESTIMATE THE NUMBER OF ELECTRIC VEHICLES IN OPERATION
- 23 IN THE STATE NECESSARY TO ACHIEVE THE GOALS OF § 2–1205(C)(2) OF THE
- 24 ENVIRONMENT ARTICLE; AND



- 1 (2) ESTIMATE THE NUMBER AND DETERMINE THE DENSITY AND LOCATION OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS NECESSARY TO CONVENIENTLY SUSTAIN THE NUMBER OF VEHICLES ESTIMATED UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

- 7 (1) SHALL DEVELOP PLANS AND IMPLEMENT PROGRAMS TO 8 INCREASE THE ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING INFRASTRUCTURE NECESSARY TO 9 ACHIEVE THE GOALS OF § 2–1205(C)(2) OF THE ENVIRONMENT ARTICLE AND SUPPORT THE NUMBER OF VEHICLES ESTIMATED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION; AND
- 12 **(2)** MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE PLANS AND PROGRAMS DEVELOPED UNDER ITEM **(1)** OF THIS SUBSECTION.
