Preamble



- WHEREAS, There are over 350,000 Muslim Marylanders who currently reside in the State and, for generations, have contributed to enriching the artistic, business, academic, and public service communities thereby significantly increasing the vibrancy of Maryland; and
- WHEREAS, There are over 250,000 Jewish Marylanders who currently reside in the State and, for generations, have contributed to enriching the artistic, business, academic, and public service communities thereby significantly increasing the vibrancy of Maryland; now, therefore,
- 9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 10 That Section(s) 7–501 through 7–503 and 7–504 through 7–507 of Article – General 11 Provisions of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7–502 12 through 7–504 and 7–506 through 7–509, respectively.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 24 (A) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF MAY AS
 25 JEWISH AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH IN RECOGNITION OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS
 26 THAT JEWISH AMERICANS HAVE MADE TO THE STATE.
- 27 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL 28 ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE JEWISH AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH PROPERLY 29 WITH APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
