11	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

15	(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ALL EMPLOYEES, INCLUDING TEMPORARY
16	EMPLOYEES AND PART-TIME EMPLOYEES, OF ALL UNITS IN THE EXECUTIVE,
17	JUDICIAL, AND LEGISLATIVE BRANCHES OF STATE GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING ANY
18	UNIT WITH AN INDEPENDENT PERSONNEL SYSTEM.
19	(B) ON REQUEST, AN EMPLOYEE SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION MAY BE
20	ENTITLED TO CANCER SCREENING LEAVE WITH PAY.

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- 1 (1) USE UP TO 4 HOURS OF CANCER SCREENING LEAVE IN ANY 2 12-MONTH PERIOD FOR CANCER SCREENING; AND
- 3 (2) USE CANCER SCREENING LEAVE ONLY AFTER OBTAINING 4 APPROVAL FROM THE EMPLOYEE'S APPOINTING AUTHORITY.
- 5 (D) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS GOVERNING CANCER SCREENING LEAVE, INCLUDING REGULATIONS THAT ESTABLISH CONDITIONS AND PROCEDURES FOR REQUESTING AND APPROVING CANCER SCREENING LEAVE.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 9 1, 2025.
