18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – State Personnel and Pensions

21 9–1101.

Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, this subtitle applies to all employees in the State Personnel Management System, except temporary employees.

2 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ALL EMPLOYEES, INCLUDING TEMPORARY 3 EMPLOYEES, IN THE EXECUTIVE, JUDICIAL, AND LEGISLATIVE BRANCHES OF 4 STATE GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING ANY UNIT WITH AN INDEPENDENT PERSONNEL 5 SYSTEM.

6 (B) AN EMPLOYEE SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION IS ENTITLED TO COLLEAGUE 7 BEREAVEMENT LEAVE WITH PAY.

8 (C) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AN EMPLOYEE 9 MAY USE UP TO 5 DAYS OF COLLEAGUE BEREAVEMENT LEAVE IMMEDIATELY 10 FOLLOWING THE DEATH OF A COLLEAGUE WHO IS EMPLOYED BY THE SAME AGENCY 11 AS THE EMPLOYEE IF:

(I) THE COLLEAGUE'S DEATH OCCURS ON THE JOB; AND

13(II) THE EMPLOYEE WORKS IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO THE14COLLEAGUE WHO DIED.

15 (2) AN EMPLOYEE MAY USE COLLEAGUE BEREAVEMENT LEAVE ONLY
 16 AFTER NOTIFYING THE EMPLOYEE'S APPOINTING AUTHORITY OF THE EMPLOYEE'S
 17 INTENTION TO USE COLLEAGUE BEREAVEMENT LEAVE.

18 (3) AN EMPLOYEE'S APPOINTING AUTHORITY MAY NOT REQUIRE AN 19 EMPLOYEE ENTITLED TO USE COLLEAGUE BEREAVEMENT LEAVE UNDER 20 PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION TO USE ANY OTHER PAID LEAVE AVAILABLE 21 TO THE EMPLOYEE.

22 (D) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS GOVERNING COLLEAGUE 23 BEREAVEMENT LEAVE.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 October 1, 2025.
