- 6 (i) determine the basis for the development of the Emory Grove 7 urban renewal program and the guidelines and execution of the program, including how 8 property was acquired or purchased from landowners;
- 9 (ii) analyze the way urban renewal was administered in Emory 10 Grove;
- 11 (iii) analyze the decisions to use the urban renewal program in 12 Emory Grove and the equity impacts of the program;
- 13 (iv) analyze the guidelines and execution of the urban renewal 14 program in Emory Grove, including the purchase of property from landowners and the 15 demolition of homes;
- 16 (v) determine the basis for the purchase of property from 17 landowners in Emory Grove and identify the details of land purchases, including the 18 purchase prices and purchase agreements; and
- (vi) analyze the plan for providing replacement properties or new homeownership for the displaced residents of Emory Grove and the equity impacts of the plan, including proposed dates to provide new replacement properties and incentives or benefits for previous landowners; and
- 23 (2) if deemed appropriate by the Task Force, recommend remedies for past 24 inequities in the purchase of land by Montgomery County through the urban renewal 25 program in Emory Grove from 1960 to 1985, including methods for determining eligibility 26 and providing compensation, such as benefits for former landowners and incentives for 27 construction projects.
- 28 (h) (1) On or before December 15, 2025, the Task Force shall submit an interim 29 report of its findings and recommendations to the Montgomery County Council, the 30 Montgomery County Executive, and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government 31 Article, the Montgomery County delegation to the General Assembly.
- 32 (2) On or before December 15, 2026, the Task Force shall submit a final 33 report of its findings and recommendations to the Montgomery County Council, the 34 Montgomery County Executive, and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government 35 Article, the Montgomery County delegation to the General Assembly.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1 1, 2025. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and 1 month and, at the end of June 2 30, 2027, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be 3 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
