

- 10 (l) To the extent required by regulations adopted under subsection (k) of this section, the Trust and the Commission shall submit to the Board of Public Works for the Board's approval each African American Heritage Grant that is to be financed through the sale of State general obligation bonds.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
