- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 Article – Health Occupations

- 22 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 23 (b) "Board" means the State Board of Massage Therapy Examiners.



- 1 (d) "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license issued by the 2 Board to practice massage therapy.
- 3 (e) "Licensed massage therapist" means an individual who is licensed by the 4 Board to practice massage therapy.
- 5 (i) "Supervised hands—on techniques" means massage techniques that are 6 performed under the direct, in—person supervision of a qualified licensed instructor who is 7 on—site in:
- 8 (1) A classroom;
- 9 (2) A laboratory;
- 10 (3) A school clinic; or
- 11 (4) A health care setting.

- 13 (A) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS
- 14 ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD, THE BOARD SHALL ESTABLISH CONTINUING
- 15 EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS AS A CONDITION OF THE RENEWAL OF A LICENSE
- 16 UNDER THIS TITLE.
- 17 (B) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO:
- 18 (1) APPROVE CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES REQUIRED UNDER 19 THIS SECTION; AND
- 20 (2) ESTABLISH THE NUMBER OF HOURS OF CONTINUING EDUCATION
- 21 REQUIRED, AT LEAST HALF OF WHICH MUST INCLUDE SUPERVISED HANDS-ON
- 22 TECHNIQUES.
- 23 (C) AT THE TIME A LICENSEE APPLIES FOR LICENSE RENEWAL, THE
- 24 APPLICANT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE BOARD, ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE BOARD, A
- 25 CERTIFICATION THAT THE APPLICANT HAS ATTENDED THE REQUIRED COURSES.
- 26 (D) THE BOARD MAY REFUSE TO RENEW THE LICENSE OF A LICENSED 27 MASSAGE THERAPIST WHO HAS:
- 28 (1) FAILED TO ATTEND THE REQUIRED COURSES; OR
- 29 (2) FAILED TO SUBMIT CERTIFICATION OF ATTENDANCE AT THE 30 REQUIRED COURSES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 2 $\,$ 1, 2026.
