Article – Environment

(a) Except as specifically provided in this title, a riparian owner may not be
 deprived of any right, privilege, or enjoyment of riparian ownership that the riparian owner
 had prior to July 1, 1970.

6 (A) (1) FOLLOWING THE COMPLETION OF ANY IMPROVEMENTS 7 CONSISTING OF SHORELINE STABILIZATION MEASURES AUTHORIZED UNDER § 8 16–201(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PRECISELY UPDATE THE 9 LANDWARD BOUNDARIES OF THE RELEVANT WETLANDS.

10(2) THE LANDWARD BOUNDARIES OF THE WETLANDS SHALL BE11SHOWN ON SUITABLE MAPS OR AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHS ON A SCALE OF 1 INCH TO 20012FEET.

13 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE 14 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2025.

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
