FOR the purpose of clarifying that a parent of the recipient may provide services for the recipient of self-directed services under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the Developmental Disabilities Administration self-directed services.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 (a) The Administration shall provide to a recipient who receives self-directed 17 services:

18 (4) An option for a **PARENT, ANOTHER** family member, or A legal guardian
19 of the recipient to provide services for the recipient, if:

(i) The recipient or an individual authorized to make care decisions
on behalf of the recipient chooses the PARENT, family member, OR LEGAL GUARDIAN to
provide the services; and

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(ii) The recipient also hires a support broker;

2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 3 October 1, 2025.
