(a) The Administration shall provide to a recipient who receives self-directed services:
(4) An option for a PARENT, ANOTHER family member, or A legal guardian of the recipient to provide services for the recipient, if:
(i) The recipient or an individual authorized to make care decisions on behalf of the recipient chooses the PARENT, family member, OR LEGAL GUARDIAN to provide the services; and
(ii) The recipient also hires a support broker; AND
(III) THE SERVICES ARE AUTHORIZED TO BE PROVIDED BY THE PARENT, ANOTHER FAMILY MEMBER, OR THE LEGAL GUARDIAN OF THE RECIPIENT BY AN ADMINISTRATION WAIVER APPROVED BY THE CENTERS FOR MEDICARE AND MEDICAID SERVICES;
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
