## Local Government - Excise Tax on Plastic and Paper Carryout Bags

- FOR the purpose of requiring a county to impose an excise tax on the amount of a fee charged by a retailer to a customer for a plastic or paper carryout bag that exceeds the amount required by local law; providing for the allocation of the excise tax revenue between the county and the State; and generally relating to an excise tax on certain fees for plastic and paper carryout bags.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "RETAILER" MEANS A PERSON ENGAGED IN THE 18 RETAIL SALE OF GOODS.
- 19 (B) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, IF A COUNTY ENACTS A
- 20  $\,$  LOCAL LAW THAT REQUIRES A RETAILER TO CHARGE AT THE POINT OF SALE A FEE

  19 REQUIRED BY LOCAL LAW.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
