19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "RETAILER" MEANS A PERSON ENGAGED IN THE 20 RETAIL SALE OF GOODS.

21 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO EACH COUNTY AND MUNICIPALITY.

22 (C) IF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY ENACTS A LOCAL LAW THAT 23 AUTHORIZES OR REQUIRES A RETAILER TO CHARGE A FEE AT THE POINT OF SALE

1 FOR PROVIDING A PLASTIC OR PAPER CARRYOUT BAG TO A CUSTOMER, THE 2 RETAILER MAY NOT CHARGE THE FEE FOR ANY TRANSACTION FOR WHICH THE 3 CUSTOMER MAKES A PURCHASE USING A FORM OF PAYMENT ISSUED AS PART OF:

4 (1) THE FEDERAL SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE 5 PROGRAM; OR

6 (2) THE FEDERAL SPECIAL SUPPLEMENTAL FOOD PROGRAM FOR 7 WOMEN, INFANTS, AND CHILDREN.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2025.
