15 16 17	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "MAIL OR PACKAGE" MEANS AN ITEM DELIVERED OR LEFT TO BE COLLECTED BY THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OR A DELIVERY SERVICE COMPANY THAT DELIVERS TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY.
18 19 20 21	(B) A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY OR WILLFULLY AND WITHOUT PERMISSION OF THE INTENDED RECIPIENT OF THE MAIL OR PACKAGE OBTAIN OR EXERT CONTROL OVER MAIL OR A PACKAGE DELIVERED TO ANOTHER WITH THE INTENT TO DEPRIVE THE OWNER OF THE MAIL OR PACKAGE.



- 1 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND 2 ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 5 YEARS.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 October 1, 2025.
