2 **Prince George's County – Federal Bureau of Investigation Headquarters –**
3 **Mandated Appropriation**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to include certain funding in the annual
5 operating or capital budget bill for site redevelopment and transportation
6 infrastructure improvements for the Federal Bureau of Investigation Headquarters
7 if a certain condition is met; and generally relating to a mandated appropriation for
8 site redevelopment and transportation infrastructure improvements for the Federal
9 Bureau of Investigation Headquarters in Prince George's County.

10 BY adding to

11 Article – State Finance and Procurement

12 Section 7–110.1

13 Annotated Code of Maryland

14 (2021 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

18 **7–110.1.**

19 **IF THE U.S. GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION RELOCATES THE**
20 **FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION HEADQUARTERS TO PRINCE GEORGE'S**

1 COUNTY, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL OPERATING OR CAPITAL
