12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 17	(A) A PERSON MAY NOT INTENTIONALLY HARASS, INTIMIDATE, OR THREATEN A PERSON:
18 19 20	(1) WHILE HIDING OR CONCEALING THEIR FACE WITH A MASK OR ANY OTHER ARTICLE OR DEVICE WITH THE PURPOSE OF CONCEALING THE PERSON'S IDENTITY; AND
21 22	(2) WITH THE INTENT TO PLACE ANOTHER PERSON IN REASONABLE FEAR OF THEIR PHYSICAL SAFETY.



- 1 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR 2 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO:
- 3 (1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 90 DAYS 4 OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR BOTH; AND
- 5 (2) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, IMPRISONMENT NOT 6 EXCEEDING 180 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.
- 7 (C) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, A CONVICTION UNDER THIS 8 SECTION MAY NOT MERGE WITH A CONVICTION FOR ANY OTHER CRIME BASED ON 9 THE ACT ESTABLISHING THE VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.
- 10 **(D)** A SENTENCE IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE SEPARATE FROM AND CONSECUTIVE TO OR CONCURRENT WITH A SENTENCE FOR ANY CRIME BASED ON THE ACT ESTABLISHING THE VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.
- 13 (E) IT IS AN AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE IN A PROCEEDING UNDER THIS 14 SECTION THAT THE PERSON WAS:
- 15 (1) WEARING A MASK OR FACE COVERING IN CELEBRATION OF A
  16 HOLIDAY, CELEBRATION, OR OTHER EVENT WHERE MASKS OR FACE COVERINGS ARE
  17 TRADITIONALLY WORN;
- 18 (2) WEARING A MASK, HOOD, ARTICLE, OR OTHER DEVICE AS
  19 PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AS PART OF THE PERSON'S OCCUPATION,
  20 TRADE, OR PROFESSION;
- 21 (3) WEARING A MASK, HOOD, ARTICLE, OR OTHER DEVICE FOR THE 22 PURPOSE OF PROTECTION FROM WEATHER ELEMENTS OR WHILE PARTICIPATING IN 23 A WINTER SPORT;
- 24 (4) WEARING A MASK, HOOD, ARTICLE, OR OTHER DEVICE IN AN 25 ARTISTIC OR THEATRICAL PRODUCTION OR CELEBRATION;
- 26 (5) WEARING A GAS MASK OR OTHER PROTECTIVE FACIAL COVERING 27 FOR THE PURPOSES OF PROTECTION DURING OR RELATING TO AN EMERGENCY 28 SITUATION OR DURING AN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DRILL;
- 29 (6) WEARING A MASK TO LIMIT THE SPREAD OF AIRBORNE ILLNESSES;  $30~{\rm OR}$
- 31 (7) WEARING ANY GARMENT FOR RELIGIOUS PURPOSES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

2 October 1, 2025.
