2 **Allegany County – Alcoholic Beverages – Minimum Age for Employment of**
3 **Underage Individuals**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the minimum age for employment in Allegany County for
5 alcoholic beverages license holders that do not derive a certain percentage of
6 revenues from the sale of food; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in
7 Allegany County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis**

4 (a) (1) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
5 SUBSECTION, A license holder may employ an individual between the ages of [16] 18 and
6 21 years.

7 (2) A LICENSE HOLDER THAT DERIVES MORE THAN HALF OF ITS
8 REVENUES FROM THE SALE OF FOOD MAY EMPLOY AN INDIVIDUAL BETWEEN THE
9 AGES OF 16 AND 21 YEARS.

10 (b) To be allowed to sell or serve beer, light wine, and liquor, an individual shall
11 be at least 18 years old.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
13 1, 2025.
