18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 (a) (1) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 2 SUBSECTION, A license holder may employ an individual between the ages of [16] 18 and 3 21 years.

4 (2) A LICENSE HOLDER THAT DERIVES MORE THAN HALF OF ITS 5 REVENUES FROM THE SALE OF FOOD MAY EMPLOY AN INDIVIDUAL BETWEEN THE 6 AGES OF 16 AND 21 YEARS.

7 (b) To be allowed to sell or serve beer, light wine, and liquor, an individual shall 8 be at least 18 years old.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 10 1, 2025.
