WHEREAS, Governor Wes Moore has made commitment to public service a preeminent issue of his administration by establishing the Maryland Department of Service and Civic Innovation, launching the service year option for high school graduates, and expanding on the promise of Maryland Corps; and



- 1 (4) THE APPROPRIATION SHALL INCLUDE FUNDING FOR THE 2 MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ENSURE, AT A MINIMUM, THAT 3 34 INTERNS ARE ANNUALLY ENROLLED IN THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FELLOWS PROGRAM.
- 5 (b) The Governor may provide funding in the State budget to the Shriver Center 6 to administer the Program.
