A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Correctional Services – Home Detention – Removal**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Commissioner of Correction or the Commissioner's
4 designee to remove an incarcerated individual from home detention under certain
5 circumstances; and generally relating to home detention.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Correctional Services**

14 3–413.

15 (A) The Commissioner or the Commissioner's designee may remove an
16 incarcerated individual from the program at any time and for any reason.

17 (B) **THE COMMISSIONER OR THE COMMISSIONER'S DESIGNEE SHALL**
18 **REMOVE AN INCARCERATED INDIVIDUAL FROM THE PROGRAM FOR VIOLATING A**
19 **CONDITION OF THE INCARCERATED INDIVIDUAL'S PLACEMENT IN THE PROGRAM.**

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2025.
