2 (B) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL 3 MAY ALLOW A STUDENT WHO IS NOT ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL TO PARTICIPATE IN 4 AN ATHLETIC ACTIVITY SPONSORED BY THE SCHOOL TO THE SAME EXTENT THAT A 5 STUDENT WHO IS ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE ATHLETIC 6 ACTIVITY IF THE STUDENT WHO IS NOT ENROLLED PARTICIPATES IN A HOME 7 INSTRUCTION PROGRAM PER COMAR GUIDELINES.

8 (C) A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL SHALL GIVE PLACEMENT PRIORITY TO A 9 STUDENT ENROLLED IN THE PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL SPONSORING THE 10 EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY OVER A STUDENT WHO IS NOT ENROLLED IN THE 11 PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IF THERE ARE A LIMITED NUMBER OF SPACES AVAILABLE FOR 12 STUDENTS IN THE EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY.
