# (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ABORTION-INDUCING DRUG" MEANS A DRUG, MEDICINE, OR A MEDICINAL OR CHEMICAL PREPARATION FOR INTERNAL HUMAN CONSUMPTION THAT IS DESIGNED TO INDUCE AN ABORTION.

### 21 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY CAUSE ANOTHER TO 22 INGEST AN ABORTION–INDUCING DRUG:



1 (1) WHEN THE PERSON KNOWS OR BELIEVES THAT THE OTHER 2 PERSON IS PREGNANT; AND

- 3 (2) (I) WITHOUT CONSENT;
- 4 (II) THROUGH FRAUD OR COERCION; OR
- 5 (III) BY FORCE OR THREAT OF FORCE.

### 6 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND 7 ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 25 YEARS.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2025.
