# 2 Natural Resources – Public Clam Fishery Area – Establishment

17(A) IN CONSULTATION WITH THE TIDAL **FISHERIES** ADVISORY COMMISSION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IDENTIFY BY REGULATION THE PUBLIC 18 19 CLAM FISHERY AREA IN THE CHESAPEAKE BAY BASED ON COMMERCIAL 20 HARVESTING ACTIVITY DURING THE 3 YEARS PRECEDING JUNE 1, 2025, ANY 21SURVEYS CONDUCTED BY THE DEPARTMENT, AND OTHER QUANTITATIVE DATA 22KNOWN OR MADE AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT.

23(B)THE PUBLIC CLAM FISHERY AREA MAY NOT BE LEASED FOR SHELLFISH24AQUACULTURE.
