A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Election Law – Affiliating With a Party and Voting – Unaffiliated Voters

- FOR the purpose of authorizing unaffiliated voters to request to affiliate with a political
 party at an early voting center during a primary election and vote a ballot for the
 voter's preferred political party; and generally relating to affiliating with a political
 party and voting in a primary election.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19Article Election Law
- 20 3-303.

21 (a) Notification of a change of party affiliation or a change to or from a decline 22 may be made:

(1) by information provided on a voter registration application by the same
methods provided for registration under Subtitle 2 of this title;

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1 (2) by written notice, signed by the voter and sent by mail or otherwise 2 delivered to the local board in the county where the voter's current voter registration 3 address is located or to which the voter has moved;

4 (3) by making application in person at the office of the local board in the 5 county where the voter's current voter registration address is located or to which the voter 6 has moved;

7 (4) by information on a voter authority card or other appropriate form filled
8 out in a polling place; or

- 9 (5) by changing a name or address with the Motor Vehicle Administration.
- 10 (b) Party affiliation changes or changes to or from a decline:
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- (1) shall be processed at any time that registration is open; and

12 (2) except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, may not be processed 13 when registration is closed.

14 (c) (1) If a local board receives a request for a party affiliation change after the 15 close of registration, the local board shall make the change and it shall become effective for 16 the next election provided:

17 [(1)] (I) there is sufficient evidence, as determined by the local boards 18 pursuant to regulations adopted by the State Board, that the request was mailed on or 19 before the close of registration for that election; or

20 [(2)] (II) the request was submitted by the voter to the Motor Vehicle 21 Administration, a voter registration agency, another local board, or the State Board on or 22 before the close of registration for that election.

(2) DURING A PRIMARY ELECTION, A VOTER WHO HAS DECLINED TO AFFILIATE WITH A POLITICAL PARTY MAY REQUEST TO AFFILIATE WITH A POLITICAL PARTY AT AN EARLY VOTING CENTER.

(a) (1) During early voting, an individual may appear in person at an early
voting center in the individual's county of residence and apply to register to vote or change
the voter's address on an existing voter registration.

30 (2) DURING EARLY VOTING BEFORE A PRIMARY ELECTION, AN
 31 INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS DECLINED TO AFFILIATE WITH A POLITICAL PARTY MAY
 32 APPEAR IN PERSON AT AN EARLY VOTING CENTER IN THE INDIVIDUAL'S COUNTY OF

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RESIDENCE AND APPLY TO CHANGE THE VOTER'S EXISTING VOTER REGISTRATION
 TO AFFILIATE WITH A POLITICAL PARTY.

3 (E) (1) WHEN A VOTER WHO HAS DECLINED TO AFFILIATE WITH A 4 POLITICAL PARTY APPLIES TO CHANGE THE VOTER'S EXISTING VOTER 5 REGISTRATION TO AFFILIATE WITH A POLITICAL PARTY DURING EARLY VOTING 6 BEFORE A PRIMARY ELECTION, THE ELECTION JUDGE SHALL DETERMINE WHETHER 7 THE VOTER RESIDES IN THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE VOTER SEEKS TO VOTE.

8 (2) IF THE VOTER IS A RESIDENT OF THE COUNTY, THE ELECTION 9 JUDGE SHALL:

10 (I) ISSUE THE VOTER A VOTER AUTHORITY CARD;

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(II) HAVE THE VOTER SIGN THE VOTER AUTHORITY CARD; AND

12 (III) ISSUE THE VOTER A BALLOT FOR THE APPROPRIATE 13 POLITICAL PARTY.

14 [(e)] (F) The State Board shall adopt regulations and procedures in accordance 15 with the requirements of this section for the administration of voter registration during 16 early voting.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2025.
