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## 1 AN ACT concerning

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## Health Insurance - Provider Directory - Required Updates

- 3 FOR the purpose of renaming "network directory" to be "provider directory" to conform to a certain federal law; altering the time period within which a carrier is certain 4 carriers are required to update the information that must be made available in the 5 6 carrier's provider directory on the Internet; requiring a carrier to verify and, as 7 necessary, update the carrier's provider directory with a certain frequency altering 8 the information required to be included in a provider directory; requiring that a 9 provider directory in printed form include a certain statement regarding the 10 accuracy of the provider information; and generally relating to provider directories of health insurance carriers. 11
