15 16	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
17 18	(2) "OWNER" MEANS A PERSON WHO HAS A LAWFUL INTEREST IN OR IS IN LAWFUL POSSESSION OF POINTS.
19 20 21	(3) (I) "POINTS" MEANS A TYPE OF CURRENCY EARNED BY A CUSTOMER OF A BUSINESS BY COMPLETING REQUIREMENTS SET BY THE BUSINESS THAT THE CUSTOMER MAY REDEEM FOR BENEFITS, GOODS, OR SERVICES.

9 10	(C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND ON CONVICTION:
11 12	(1) IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 5 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$10,000 OR BOTH; AND
13	(2) SHALL PAY THE OWNER THE VALUE OF THE POINTS.
