9 10	(g) (1) A provider that seeks to participate on a provider panel of a carrier shall submit an application to the carrier.
11 12 13	(2) (i) Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph and paragraph (3) of this subsection, the carrier, after reviewing the application, shall accept or reject the provider for participation on the carrier's provider panel.
14 15 16 17	(ii) A carrier may not reject a provider who provides community—based health services for a program accredited under COMAR 10.63.02 for participation on the carrier's provider panel because the provider practices within the scope of the provider's license and is:
18 19	1. a <del>licensed graduate social worker or a</del> licensed master social worker, as <del>those terms are</del> defined in § 19–101 of the Health Occupations Article;

5 6 7 8	4. This subparagraph does not apply to a carrier that arranges a dental provider panel until the Commissioner certifies that the online credentialing system is capable of accepting the uniform credentialing form designated by the Commissioner for dental provider panels.
9 10 11	(ii) 1. A carrier that receives an incomplete application shall return the application to the provider at the address listed in the application within 10 days after the date the application is received.
12 13	2. The carrier shall indicate to the provider what information is needed to make the application complete.
14 15	3. The provider may return the completed application to the carrier.
16 17	4. After the carrier receives the completed application, the carrier is subject to the time periods established in paragraph (3) of this subsection.
18 19	(5) A carrier may charge a reasonable fee for an application submitted to the carrier under this section.
20 21	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
