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Sickle Cell Disease – Institutions of Higher Education – Policies, Procedures, and Educational Campaigns

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an institution of higher education from denying access or services to a student based on the student's diagnosis of sickle cell disease; requiring 5 6 an institution of higher education to provide reasonable accommodations for 7 students with sickle cell disease; requiring the Maryland Department of Health to 8 develop an education and awareness campaign for institutions of higher education 9 in the State regarding students with sickle cell disease; requiring the Department, 10 in consultation with the Maryland Higher Education Commission, to develop 11 uniform procedures for institutions of higher education in the State to follow in assessing, supporting, and treating students with sickle cell disease; requiring the 12 13 Department to develop or compile materials to provide a comprehensive education 14 on sickle cell disease to certain faculty and staff at institutions of higher education 15 in the State; and generally relating to sickle cell disease and institutions of higher 16 education.

- 22 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP OR COMPILE MATERIALS TO

- 24 AT AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE WITH A COMPREHENSIVE

- 1 (C) EACH INSTITUTE OF HIGHER EDUCATION IS ENCOURAGED TO CONDUCT 2 AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS AND EDUCATIONAL SESSIONS BASED ON THE MATERIALS 3 DEVELOPED OR COMPILED UNDER THIS SECTION AS FINANCIAL RESOURCES ALLOW.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2025.
