BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Transportation Section 16–1002 and 18–103(a) and (b) Annotated Code of Maryland (2020 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Transportation

7 8	(b) (1) A person may not rent a motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer to any other person unless the lessor or his agent:
9	(i) Has inspected the license to drive OR ELECTRONIC CREDENTIAL of the individual who will operate the rented vehicle;
1	(ii) Has compared and verified:
12 13 14	1. The signature on the license OR ELECTRONIC CREDENTIAL with the signature of the individual, as written in the presence of the lessor or agent; and
15 16	2. The physical description on the license OR ELECTRONIC CREDENTIAL with the physical appearance of the individual; and
17	(iii) Has verified that the license is not expired.
18 19	(2) An inspection of a license OR AN ELECTRONIC CREDENTIAL under this section may be through electronic or digital means.
20 21 22	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be construed to affect the ability of the Motor Vehicle Administration to authorize and implement the use of electronic credentials in matters other than rental vehicle transactions.
23 24	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
