$\frac{1}{2}$	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 16 17	(a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection and subject to the approval of the Department, a county board may establish one virtual school for the elementary, middle, and high school grade bands.
18 19 20	(2) The Department may provide preliminary authorization to a county board to establish one additional virtual school on a showing of just cause, as determined by the Department.

The Department may revoke approval of a virtual school if during the

previous school year the virtual school fails to meet the standards established by the

Department in regulation.

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- 1 (4) (i) A county board may appeal a denial or revocation of approval for 2 the establishment of a virtual school to the State Board for adjudication during a public 3 hearing.
- 4 (ii) The State Board shall develop an appeals process to carry out the 5 provisions of this paragraph.
- 6 (b) A virtual school may not include classes for prekindergarten or kindergarten 7 students.
- 8 (c) A virtual school is subject to all applicable federal and State laws and 9 regulations governing the operation of a public school.
- 10 (d) Each approved virtual school shall have a unique school code assigned by the 11 Department.
- 12 (e) [(1)] A county board may [not] contract with a for-profit entity[, but may contract with] **OR** a nonprofit entity[,] to operate or administer a virtual school for the county board.
- [(2) The provisions of paragraph (1) of this subsection may not be construed to prohibit a county board from contracting with a for–profit entity for goods and services for a virtual school.]
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
