19 20	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 9 MEANS GROUPS, CAUSES, OR IDEOLOGIES THAT:
- 1. PROMOTE WHITE SUPREMACY AND THE IDEA THAT
- 11 WHITE PEOPLE ARE SUPERIOR TO BIPOC;
- 12 **2.** PROMOTE RELIGIOUS AND RACIAL BIGOTRY;
- 3. SEEK TO EXACERBATE RACIAL AND ETHNIC TENSIONS
- 14 BETWEEN BIPOC AND NON-BIPOC; OR
- 4. ENGAGE IN PATENTLY HATEFUL AND INFLAMMATORY
- 16 SPEECH, INTIMIDATION, AND VIOLENCE AGAINST BIPOC AS A MEANS OF
- 17 PROMOTING WHITE SUPREMACY.
- 18 (2) THE COMMISSION SHALL PROHIBIT POLICE OFFICERS FROM:
- 19 (I) AFFILIATING WITH, SUPPORTING, OR ADVOCATING FOR
- 20 WHITE SUPREMACIST GROUPS, CAUSES, OR IDEOLOGIES; OR
- 21 (II) PARTICIPATING IN OR ACTIVELY PROMOTING AN
- 22 INTERNATIONAL OR DOMESTIC EXTREMIST GROUP THAT THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF
- 23 INVESTIGATION HAS DETERMINED SUPPORTS OR ENCOURAGES ILLEGAL VIOLENT
- 24 CONDUCT.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 2025.
