SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That: (a) (1) The Maryland Judiciary shall provide a comprehensive report on the impact and effectiveness of Truancy Reduction Pilot Programs in the State based on: (i) student GPA: (ii) graduation rate; and (iii) truancy rate. The report shall make recommendations regarding whether a Truancy Reduction Pilot Program would be effective in the Eighth Judicial Circuit of Baltimore City. On or before December 1, 2026, the Maryland Judiciary shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.
