- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 A PROCUREMENT OFFICER MAY NOT REQUIRE A BIDDER OR OFFEROR, AS A 17 CONDITION TO SUBMITTING A BID OR PROPOSAL ON A STATE PROCUREMENT, TO 18 CERTIFY THAT THE BIDDER OR OFFEROR, EXCEPT AS REQUIRED UNDER THIS 19 ARTICLE OR UNDER FEDERAL LAW:

A PROCUREMENT OFFICER MAY NOT INCLUDE IN A STATE PROCUREMENT CONTRACT, OR RENEWAL OF A CONTRACT, A CLAUSE REQUIRING THE CONTRACTOR TO CERTIFY THAT THE CONTRACTOR, EXCEPT AS REQUIRED UNDER THIS ARTICLE OR UNDER FEDERAL LAW:

- (1) IS NOT ENGAGING IN A BOYCOTT OF A FOREIGN COUNTRY; OR

7 (2) WILL REFRAIN FROM A BOYCOTT OF A FOREIGN COUNTRY FOR 8 THE DURATION OF THE CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATIONS.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2025.
