14 15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 19	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
20	(2) "COVERED ENTITY" MEANS:
21	(I) A COUNTY BOARD;
22	(II) A COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT;

15	(I) MAY BE WITHHELD FROM DISCLOSURE BY LAW; OR

17 18 19 20	(C) (1) (I) ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1 EACH YEAR, EACH COVERED ENTITY SHALL REPORT TO THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT A LIST OF EACH PROCUREMENT CONTRACT OR MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ENTERED INTO IN THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR BY THE COVERED ENTITY.
21 22 23	(II) A COVERED ENTITY THAT IS A COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OR A SCHOOL IN THE PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION SYSTEM OF THE STATE MAY SATISFY THE REPORTING REQUIREMENT UNDER

- 5 2. SUBMIT THE REPORT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257
- 6 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION
- 7 COMMITTEE, THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION, ENERGY, AND THE
- 8 ENVIRONMENT, THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE, AND THE HOUSE WAYS
- 9 AND MEANS COMMITTEE.
- 10 (II) THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF 11 THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL INCLUDE:
- 1. A LIST OF EACH PROCUREMENT CONTRACT AND
- 13 $\,$ MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ENTERED INTO BY EACH COVERED ENTITY;
- 14 **2.** THE TOTAL AMOUNT REQUIRED TO BE PAID BY A COVERED ENTITY UNDER A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT; AND
- 3. THE TOTAL AMOUNT PAID BY A COVERED ENTITY DURING THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
