- 4 (B) "ADAPTED VEHICLE" MEANS A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT HAS BEEN
- 5 MODIFIED TO BE OPERATED BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO REQUIRES A WHEELCHAIR FOR

- 19 (III) INFORMATION REGARDING THE AVAILABILITY OF

- 23 (3) IN REPORTING THE DATA REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2)(II)
- 24 OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE REASONABLE EFFORTS TO
- 25 ANONYMIZE THE DATA TO PROTECT THE PRIVACY OF RECIPIENTS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- October 1, 2025. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of September
- 28 30, 2030, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be
- 29 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
