1 (d) An applicant qualifies under this section if the applicant: (1) 2 subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, has at least 12 years 3 of work experience in engineering that is satisfactory to the Board and that indicates to the Board that the applicant may be competent to practice engineering; and 4 5 1. has passed the examination IN THE FUNDAMENTALS OF (ii) 6 ENGINEERING GIVEN BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; AND 7 2. **AFTER PASSING** THE **EXAMINATION** IN THE 8 FUNDAMENTALS OF ENGINEERING, HAS PASSED THE EXAMINATION in the principles 9 and practice of engineering given by the Board under this subtitle. 10 If an applicant has completed 1 or more years of a college or university 11 curriculum in engineering that the Board approves, it may allow, for each of those years, a 1-year credit towards the experience requirement of paragraph (1)(i) of this subsection. 12 13 If an applicant has completed 1 or more years of a college or university (3)curriculum in engineering that has not been approved by the Board, the Board may allow, 14 for each of those years, a credit of up to 6 months towards the experience requirement under 15 paragraph (1)(i) of this subsection. 16 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2025.
