A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Emissions Inspection Program – Testing and Inspection – Grounds for**
3 **Failure**

4 FOR the purpose of clarifying that a motor vehicle may be determined to have failed to pass
5 an emissions equipment and misfueling inspection or an exhaust emissions test only
6 for certain reasons; and generally relating to the Vehicle Emissions Inspection
7 Program.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Transportation**

21 23–202.

22 (b) (1) Subject to paragraph (3) of this subsection, the emissions control
23 program shall provide for a biennial exhaust emissions test and emissions equipment and
24 misfueling inspection for all vehicles of the 1977 model year and each model year thereafter.

2 **A FACILITY ESTABLISHED OR APPROVED UNDER § 23-303 OF THIS TITLE MAY**
3 **NOT DETERMINE THAT A MOTOR VEHICLE HAS FAILED TO PASS A TEST OR**
4 **INSPECTION REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE FOR ANY REASON OTHER THAN A**
5 **DETERMINATION THAT:**

6 **(1) FOR AN EMISSIONS EQUIPMENT AND MISFUELING INSPECTION:**

7 **(I) REQUIRED EMISSIONS EQUIPMENT IS NOT PRESENT; OR**

8 **(II) THE VEHICLE HAS BEEN MISFUELED; OR**

9 **(2) FOR AN EXHAUST EMISSIONS TEST, THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS NOT**
10 **IN COMPLIANCE WITH AN APPLICABLE EMISSIONS STANDARD.**

11 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect**
12 **October 1, 2025.**
