A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2Procurement – Public Work Contracts – Data Dashboard3(Maryland Public Works and Apprenticeship Transparency Act)

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Commissioner of Labor and Industry to develop and $\mathbf{5}$ maintain a data dashboard that includes certain information relating to contractors, 6 subcontractors, employees, and apprentices working under public work contracts; 7 requiring each contractor who is contracted under a public work contract to provide 8 certain information to the Commissioner; requiring the Commissioner to update the 9 data dashboard on a certain basis, post the data dashboard on the Maryland 10 Department of Labor website, and maintain a certain cache; and generally relating 11 to public work contracts.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 **17–206.**

3 (2) THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION REGARDING THE EMPLOYEES OF

6 (I) THE PREVAILING WAGE RATES PAID BY EACH CONTRACTOR 7 OR SUBCONTRACTOR;

8 (II) THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES EMPLOYED BY EACH 9 CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR;

10(III) THE REGULAR WAGES AND OVERTIME WAGES PAID BY THE11CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR;

12 (IV) ANY FRINGE BENEFITS PROVIDED TO EMPLOYEES BY THE 13 CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR;

14(V)THE JOB CLASSIFICATION OF EACH EMPLOYEE EMPLOYED15BY THE CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR; AND

16 (VI) ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION DETERMINED NECESSARY 17 BY THE COMMISSIONER; AND

18 (3) (I) THE NUMBER OF APPRENTICES WORKING FOR EACH 19 CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR;

20 (II) THE TRADE PRACTICED BY EACH APPRENTICE WORKING 21 FOR EACH CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR;

22 (III) THE CERTIFICATION STATUS OF EACH APPRENTICE 23 WORKING FOR EACH CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR;

24 (IV) CONTACT INFORMATION FOR EACH APPRENTICESHIP 25 PROGRAM SPONSOR;

26(V)DEMOGRAPHIC DATA FOR EACH APPRENTICE WORKING FOR27EACH CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR; AND

28 (VI) THE DATE EACH APPRENTICE REGISTERED WITH THE 29 MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF LABOR.

1 (B) EACH CONTRACTOR WHO IS CONTRACTED UNDER A PUBLIC WORK 2 CONTRACT SHALL PROVIDE THE COMMISSIONER WITH THE INFORMATION LISTED 3 UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION ONCE A WEEK.

4 (C) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL:

5 (1) UPDATE THE DATA DASHBOARD DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION
6 (A) OF THIS SECTION AT LEAST ONCE A MONTH;

7 (2) POST THE MOST RECENTLY UPDATED DATA DASHBOARD 8 PROMINENTLY ON THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF LABOR WEBSITE; AND

9 (3) MAINTAIN A CACHE CONTAINING THE INFORMATION POSTED ON 10 THE DATA DASHBOARD FOR AT LEAST THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING 24 MONTHS.

11 (D) THE COMMISSIONER MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 12 SECTION.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect14 October 1, 2025.
