CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages Licenses – Veterans’ Organizations**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a certain holder of a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license
4 in Anne Arundel County to convert the license to a Class C (veterans’ organization)
5 license; altering the annual license fee for a Class C (veterans’ organization) license;
6 authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County to provide
7 application and administrative fee discounts to certain licensees and applicants;
8 authorizing the holder of a Class C (veterans’ organization) license to operate on
9 Sunday without obtaining a Sunday license; and generally relating to alcoholic
10 beverages licenses in Anne Arundel County.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis**

4 11–102.

5 This title applies only in Anne Arundel County.

6 11–903.

7 (a) There is a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license.

8 (b) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor at retail,
9 at a club at the place described in the license, for on–premises consumption.

10 (c) The annual license fee is \$480.

11 11–1009.

12 (a) There is a Class C (veterans' organization) license.

13 (b) The Board shall issue the license for use by a local unit of a nationwide
14 nonprofit organization or club that:

15 (1) is composed only of members who served in the armed forces of the
16 United States in a war in which the United States has been engaged;

17 (2) has a charter from a national veterans' organization that was granted
18 before the application for the license was made;

19 (3) has a bona fide membership of at least 100 individuals and dues of at
20 least \$5 per year per individual; and

21 (4) operates for its members and meets in a clubhouse principally used for
22 its members.

23 (c) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor at retail
24 at the place described in the license for on–premises consumption.

25 (d) The license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor during the hours and days
26 as set out for a Class C [beer, wine, and liquor] **(VETERANS' ORGANIZATION)** license
27 under § 11–2004 of this title.

28 **(E) (1) A HOLDER OF A CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE**
29 **ISSUED UNDER § 11–903 OF THIS TITLE THAT QUALIFIES AS A VETERANS'**

1 ORGANIZATION UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION MAY APPLY TO CONVERT
2 THE LICENSE TO A CLASS C (VETERANS' ORGANIZATION) LICENSE.

3 (2) THE CONVERSION TO AND ISSUANCE OF A CLASS C (VETERANS'
4 ORGANIZATION) LICENSE UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE
5 CONSIDERED A LICENSE RENEWAL AND NOT AN ISSUANCE OF A NEW LICENSE.

6 [(e)] (F) (1) The annual license fee is [\$400] \$300.

7 (2) THE BOARD MAY PROVIDE APPLICATION AND ADMINISTRATIVE
8 FEE DISCOUNTS TO AN ORGANIZATION THAT:

9 (I) QUALIFIES AS A VETERANS' ORGANIZATION UNDER
10 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION; AND

11 (II) 1. HOLDS A CLASS C (VETERANS' ORGANIZATION)
12 LICENSE;

13 2. APPLIES FOR AN INITIAL OR RENEWAL CLASS C
14 (VETERANS' ORGANIZATION) LICENSE; OR

15 3. HOLDS A CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE
16 THAT IS CONVERTED TO A CLASS C (VETERANS' ORGANIZATION) LICENSE UNDER
17 SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION.

18 11-2004.

19 (c) (1) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS
20 SUBSECTION, A holder of a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and
21 liquor on Monday through Saturday from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day.

22 (2) Except as provided in [paragraph] PARAGRAPHS (3) AND (4) of this
23 subsection, the license holder may not sell beer, wine, or liquor after 2 a.m. on Sunday.

24 (3) The Board may issue to the license holder a Sunday license that
25 authorizes the sale of beer, wine, and liquor on Sunday according to terms that the license
26 states.

27 (4) A HOLDER OF A CLASS C (VETERANS' ORGANIZATION) LICENSE
28 UNDER § 11-1009 OF THIS TITLE MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ON MONDAY
29 THROUGH SUNDAY FROM 6 A.M. TO 2 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY WITHOUT
30 OBTAINING A SUNDAY LICENSE UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

31 [(4)] (5) The license holder may sell or provide beer, wine, and liquor at a
32 bar or counter on any day on which the sale of beer, wine, and liquor is allowed by law.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
2 1, 2025.
