- 2 (B) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR 3 CALCIUM SCORE TESTING FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE AT LEAST THREE OF THE 4 FOLLOWING RISK FACTORS:
- 5 (1) DIABETES;
- 6 (2) HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE;
- 7 (3) HIGH CHOLESTEROL; OR
- 8 (4) A FAMILY HISTORY OF PREMATURE CORONARY ARTERY DISEASE.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all policies, contracts, and health benefit plans issued, delivered, or renewed in the State on or after January 1, 2026.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 2026.
