BY adding to Article - Health Occupations Section 1-707 Annotated Code of Maryland (2021 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article – Health Occupations** 1-707. EACH HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD MAY ESTABLISH A PROCESS TO INCLUDE A NOTATION INDICATING VETERAN STATUS ON A LICENSE, CERTIFICATE, OR REGISTRATION, OR PUBLIC PROFILE AND TO ASSIST IN DETERMINING

- 3 (B) IF A HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD ESTABLISHES THE PROCESS
- 4 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE,
- 5 CERTIFICATE, OR REGISTRATION, OR PUBLIC PROFILE SHALL ALLOW AN APPLICANT

- 7 (1) PRESENT A CERTIFICATION OF VETERAN STATUS OBTAINED
- 8 FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AND MILITARY FAMILIES IN ACCORDANCE

- 31 (D) EACH HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO
- 32 CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- 33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 34 October 1, 2025.
