A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Election Law – State Administrator of Elections – Municipal Elections**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Administrator of Elections to enter into
4 memoranda of understanding with municipalities that allow the State
5 Administrator to work collaboratively with a municipality to support the
6 administration of the municipality's elections; and generally relating to the
7 administration of municipal elections.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Election Law**

21 2–103.

22 (a) There is a State Administrator of Elections.

1 **(E) THE STATE ADMINISTRATOR MAY ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF**
2 **UNDERSTANDING WITH A MUNICIPALITY, THE TERMS OF WHICH SHALL ALLOW THE**
3 **ADMINISTRATOR TO WORK COLLABORATIVELY WITH THE MUNICIPALITY TO**
4 **SUPPORT THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY'S ELECTIONS.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
6 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has
7 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to
8 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is
9 enacted.
