4 FOR the purpose of requiring, beginning on a certain date, the Maryland Medical  
5 Assistance Program to provide coverage for self-measured blood pressure  
6 monitoring for certain eligible Program recipients; ~~requiring the Program to develop~~  
7 ~~and implement a certain education campaign;~~ and generally relating to  
8 self-measured blood pressure monitoring under the Maryland Medical Assistance  
9 Program.

4 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
 5 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

6 **Article – Health – General**

7 15–101.

8 (h) “Program” means the Maryland Medical Assistance Program.

9 (j) “Self–measured blood pressure monitoring” means the regular measurement  
 10 of blood pressure by the patient outside the clinical setting, either at home or elsewhere,  
 11 requiring the use of a home blood pressure measurement device by the patient.

12 (l) “Validated home blood pressure monitor” means a blood pressure  
 13 measurement device that has been validated for accuracy and is listed in the U.S. Blood  
 14 Pressure Validated Device Listing.

15 15–103.

16 (a) (1) The Secretary shall administer the Maryland Medical Assistance  
 17 Program.

18 (2) The Program:

19 (xxiii) Beginning on July 1, 2025, shall provide, subject to the  
 20 limitations of the State budget, and as permitted by federal law, coverage for biomarker  
 21 testing in accordance with § 15–859 of the Insurance Article; [and]

22 (xxiv) Beginning on January 1, 2025, shall provide coverage for  
 23 prostheses in accordance with § 15–844 of the Insurance Article; AND

24 **(XXV) BEGINNING ON JANUARY 1, 2026, SHALL PROVIDE,**  
 25 **SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS OF THE STATE BUDGET, AND AS PERMITTED BY**
