BY adding to Article – Natural Resources Section 5–2101 and 5–2102 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 21. Playground Safety" Annotated Code of Maryland (2023 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Natural Resources SUBTITLE 21. PLAYGROUND SAFETY. 5-2101. IN THIS SUBTITLE, "PLAYGROUND" MEANS A PUBLIC OUTDOOR RECREATION
