2 **Wicomico County – Vehicle Laws – Prohibition on Roadway Solicitations**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person in Wicomico County from standing in a roadway,
4 median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations from the occupant of a
5 vehicle; and generally relating to roadway solicitations in Wicomico County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Transportation**

14 21–507.

15 (c) In Calvert County, Carroll County, Charles County, Harford County, [and]
16 Washington County, **AND WICOMICO COUNTY**, a person may not stand in a roadway,
17 median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant
18 of a vehicle.
