BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Transportation Section 21-507(c)Annotated Code of Maryland (2020 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Transportation 21-507.In Calvert County, Carroll County, Charles County, Harford County, [and] Washington County, AND WICOMICO COUNTY, a person may not stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle.
