- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring each county board of education to develop and implement a policy that prohibits students from using a cellular device during the school day 5 6 except under certain circumstances; and generally relating to county boards of 7 education and student cellular device use policy requiring the State Department of 8 Education to develop guidelines for a policy on student use of personal electronic 9 devices during school hours; requiring county boards of education, in consultation with students, parents, teachers, and school personnel, to develop and adopt a policy 10 that limits students from using personal electronic devices during school hours 11 except under certain circumstances; and generally relating to county boards of 12 education and a personal electronic device use policy for students. 13
