17 18	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 22	(a) In this title and Title 25 of this article the following words have the meanings indicated



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- 1 (c) "Bicycle path" means any travelway designed and designated by signing or 2 signing and marking for bicycle use, located within its own right-of-way or in a shared 3 right-of-way, and physically separated from motor vehicle traffic by berm, shoulder, curb, 4 or other similar device.
- 5 (e) "Bike lane" means any portion of a roadway or shoulder designated for single 6 directional bicycle flow.
- 7 21–1003.
- 8 (a) The provisions of this section apply except as necessary to avoid conflict with 9 other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or traffic control 10 device.
- 11 (GG) A PERSON MAY NOT STOP, STAND, OR PARK A VEHICLE IN A BIKE LANE 12 OR BICYCLE PATH.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
