#### **SENATE BILL 135**

1 (B) (1) UNLESS WAIVED BY THE CLIENT, A COMMUNICATION BETWEEN 2 AN ATTORNEY AND A CLIENT THAT ACTS AS A FIDUCIARY IS SUBJECT TO THE 3 ATTORNEY-CLIENT PRIVILEGE EVEN IF FIDUCIARY FUNDS ARE USED TO 4 COMPENSATE THE ATTORNEY FOR LEGAL SERVICES RENDERED TO THE CLIENT.

5 (2) THE EXISTENCE OF A FIDUCIARY RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN A 6 FIDUCIARY AND A BENEFICIARY DOES NOT CONSTITUTE OR GIVE RISE TO A WAIVER 7 OF THE ATTORNEY-CLIENT PRIVILEGE FOR COMMUNICATIONS BETWEEN THE 8 ATTORNEY AND THE FIDUCIARY.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2025.
