- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Education
- 15 7–206.1.
- 16 (a) An individual honorably discharged from military service may apply to obtain
- 17 a high school diploma if the individual withdrew from a regular full-time public or private
- 18 high school accredited by the State Board to enlist in the armed forces of the United States
- 19 during[:
- 20 (1) World War II;
- 21 (2) The Korean Conflict; or

- 1 (3) The Vietnam Conflict] AN ARMED CONFLICT AUTHORIZED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OR CONGRESS.
- 3 (b) To obtain a high school diploma under subsection (a) of this section, the 4 individual shall apply to the county board in the county where the individual resides or 5 where the school from which the individual withdrew was located.
 - (c) Each county board shall adopt rules and regulations to establish procedures for awarding diplomas under this section.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2025.
